TREE CARE GUIDE

The Bottlebrush tree (Callistemon) has a fitting name – the spikes of flowers that bloom at the ends of the stem closely resemble a bottle brush. Nectar-feeding birds are attracted to the flowers. People are attracted to the Bottlebrush because of its dense and compact growth habit, which makes it ideal to use as a privacy screen. Native to Australia, this showy plant can grow as a tree or shrub. When properly cared for, Callistemon rewards its owners with bright, colorful blooms, as well as full and healthy dark green foliage. This resilient plant grows well in USDA hardiness zones 9 to 11.
